### <u>1 – School news :</u>

### • Partnership agreement with the European school

It is being renewed and will be signed in June. It will be enforced until June 2023.

This year, from18 pupils in CM2, 12 will go to the ESH and 3 to the Finnish-French school. Two will go to Finnish schools and one is leaving Finland.

An enquiry was sent to the parents of CE2 and CM1 to ask them about their intentions after Jules Verne after the CM2 class.

Number of space is limited in the Finnish-French School; therefore, it is important to answer. Jules Verne needs to inform of the enrolment one year ahead.

### • Parents/ teacher meetings

Parents and teachers meeting for Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade have been held.

Reports cards for elementary school pupils will be available from June 4<sup>th</sup>. For children leaving school it Is important that families download the report cards from the Livreval platform. These documents are available one year only after a pupil has left.

For children in GS, 5 years old, a summary document will be given to the families. It is to be signed and send back to the teacher (except for families leaving school who keep it).

### • DELF

Pupils took this French language evaluation exam in April.

The results were very good and a 100% passed the exam. Pupils will receive a diploma.

### New School project

The new school project has been presented earlier to the parents' delegates on May 3<sup>rd</sup>. There was no changes or addition to be made. The new school project was voted unanimously.

# 2- Health and Security

### • Security

A training for extinguishing fires has been proposed by the early childhood education department. 4 staff members took part. The theory was by remote access on Tuesday April 19<sup>th</sup>, the practical part will be in September in Haaga fire station.

### Covid-19

School follows the official instructions from Helsinki city and the school department as well as the French Embassy and AEFE recommendation.

As of today, rules are unchanged.

Since we had some covid-19 cases at the end of 2020, there has not been any other at school. Parents from elementary school have to have their children tested even in case of mild symptoms and to keep them home until the result is known. This rule is respected and we thank all the families. We hope that the measures will be lighter for next school year. We will inform parents of any development before school starts in August.

### 3/ Projects, activities, outings

Because of covid-19 restrictions, we are not allowed to organize the traditional events such as the marathon and the school fair.

Classes, not all the school, will run the marathon together. However, June will be rich in events. We stayed active in spite of the pandemic and I wish to thank all the staff for the numerous projects all year long.

Thank also to the parents for their help.

### Projects :

- All classes have participated in the « Flashmob » project organized by the schools of the zone ZENOS zone. We will film it on June 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Ari Huusela, who participated in the solitary race around the world Vendée Globe, will come to meet pupils from CE1 class on May 31<sup>st</sup>. This event will be outside in the schoolyard.
- Between May 31st and June 10th pupils from CE1 and CM1/CM2 classes will present their multilinghal Kamishibaï to the oher classes. The Kamishibaï is a paper theatre presenting illustration telling a story.
- The prizes for the reading aloud competition were given to the winners. School also offered a book to each pupil having taken part in this competition.
- **Ten days Art project** was set between April 29<sup>th</sup> and May 12<sup>th</sup>. A small exhibition will be presented outside in the next few days.

- Language week between 17th and 21st of May. The CE1 class pupils were initiated to Russian, Japanese, Spanish and Farsi by pupils' parents. Thanks to Solène Lehmann who initiated this project.
- CE2/CM1 class has followed an AEFE project: « The Bees'school ». Pupils worked on different workshops : dance, Theater, posters. The aim was to have a better knowledge about the bees in order to learn to protect them.
- The CP newspaper is almost on the printing press.
